Environmental and Social Assessment

Environmental Assessment

The Promoter's RDI activities financed by the Bank concern the development of software, hardware and firmware solutions. The Project's activities which will be carried out in existing facilities, which are already authorised and will not change their already authorised scope due to the Project. The Project is not subject to an EIA as such activities are neither listed in Annex I nor Annex II of the EIA Directive 2011/92/EU amended by Directive 2014/52/EU.

The Project will contribute to develop innovative hardware, software and digital technology solutions supporting the deployment and adoption of electromobility by private customers, corporate and public sectors. It will in general help lower the existing barriers for a wider adoption of electromobility, therefore contributing to climate action mitigation. It is expected to contribute to further knowledge creation and diffusion, to the transformation of the automotive and transport industry in the direction of electrification and increased sustainability and will directly and indirectly contribute to preserving and scaling up R&D employment and contribute to economic growth in Europe.

The Promoter has recently received all the relevant certifications for properly managing environmental and social aspects, among which ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 27001, ISO 37001 and ISO 45001.

The Promoter forecasts a 33.6% gender split in 2025 out of a total of 1 211 full time equivalent (FTE) staff members. This is an improvement compared to the start situation, when there were no policies implemented
