Project Description:	Construction of a greenfield automotive glass manufacturing plant in the Atlantic Free Zone of Kenitra in Morocco. The plant produces windscreens, backlights and sidelights for the supply to automotive Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) located in North Africa and Southern Europe.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The construction of the new automotive glass factory is completed. The plant is a state-of-the-art facility that conforms to the environmental guidelines of the AGC Group, which are in line with European state-of-the-art practices.

The plant is located in the Atlantic Free Zone, which was set up since the year 2012 to host industrial activities, and it is adjacent to an agricultural area. Based on the available information, no physical displacement was necessary. The Moroccan Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) procedure included public consultation in line with EU standards (project's description, non-technical summary, localization map and publication in two official newspapers). The positive decision on the EIA from the Competent Authority was provided in July 2017.

The promoter did not report on any adverse environmental or social effects.
