Project Description: The project concerned the R&D expenditures for the software developments related to the CrystalBridge software platform. Such developments include basic technologies, new features / applications, and improvement of existing modules. The key objective of the R&D work was to further optimise the transformation process for SAP enterprise resource planning applications to increase the level of automation, to reduce the down time of the client IT systems and to adapt to the latest developments for cloud deployments, which is a key driver for such transformation projects.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The project's deliverables were primarily related to software development activities around the expansion and improvement of the promoter's CrystalBridge core platform intended to optimise the migration of the SAP ERP Central Component (ECC) to SAP S/4HANA environment for cloud deployments, enabling companies' digital transformation with automated data migrations and data management in a seamless way.

Software developments do not carry any significant environmental impact. There is no residual environmental risk associated to the RDI activities which were carried out in existing facilities.

Nonetheless, the promoter has set specific ESG goals to reduce energy consumption to the extent possible, and also endeavouring to increase the proportion of renewable energy in their energy mix. Since 2018, SNP's head office in Heidelberg has been powered by green electricity.
