Project Description:

At completion, the outputs for this public urban transport Project include:

- i. The purchase of 134 CNG 12-meter-long buses.
- ii. The purchase of 7 CNG buses (8m and 8.5m long).
- iii. The purchase of 32 electric 12-meter-long buses.
- iv. 3 charging facilities (in three different cities):
- v. One charging area in Badajoz, equipped with 23 charging points.
- vi. One charging area in Alcadia, equipped with 7 charging points.
- vii. One charging area in Palma de Mallorca, equipped with 2 charging points.
- viii. ITS systems for the concession in Palma de Mallorca.
- ix. Training sessions for the staff working in the concession in Palma de Mallorca.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The manufacturing of rolling stock (buses), software and IT systems for bus operation do not fall within the scope of the EIA Directive 2011/92/EC amended by Directive 2014/52/EU. Therefore, no EIA was required for any of the Project components.

The Promoter has provided the Bank with the details of the diesel and old CNG buses decommissioned and scrapped in the period 2019-2023.

No major negative environmental impacts were identified during Project implementation, nor reported by the Promoter at project completion.

The Project has an overall positive effect on the quality of the environment as it contributes to climate change objectives (mitigation), thanks to the lower greenhouse gases emitted by the new bus fleet replacing the old diesel buses.

The Project shall also promote an increase in the passenger's demand motivated by the more reliable public bus service due to lower bus breakdowns.
